

## Technological and Higher Education Institute of Hong Kong Precautionary Measures for Prevention of COVID-19

For protection against contracting and spreading the COVID-19 in the campus and the community, students are reminded to stay vigilant and take the following precautionary measures:

1. Students are required to complete an electronic [Student Health Declaration Form](#) in advance at home and present the confirmation email to the security officer on entry to THEi campus each day;
2. Temperature checks will be taken by the security officers at campus entrances and your student ID card must be shown for signing-in each time you enter THEi campus. Temperature checkpoints have been set up at campus entrances (1/F Plaza in CW and Gate 1 in TY);
3. You must wear your face mask when on THEi campus.
4. Social distancing measures remain in place where practicable. Space dividers and seating arrangements have been changed in learning spaces to keep social distance. Social gatherings should also be minimized, i.e., large group gatherings outside of class time.
5. If you have a fever, cough, diarrhea, vomiting or other flu-like symptoms, please do not come to campus. Seek medical advice promptly, and inform your faculty;
6. If you are required to quarantine or self-isolate under the Prevention and Control of Disease Regulation (Cap. 599), please do not come to campus, and inform your faculty.
7. Follow the advice given by the Centre for Health Protection, as below, and maintain good personal and environmental hygiene:
  - Wear a surgical mask when taking public transport or staying in crowded places. It is important to wear a mask properly, including hand hygiene before wearing and after removing a mask;
  - Perform hand hygiene frequently, especially before touching the mouth, nose or eyes; after touching public installations such as handrails or door knobs; or when hands are contaminated by respiratory secretions after coughing or sneezing; and
  - Cover your mouth and nose with tissue paper when sneezing or coughing. Dispose of soiled tissues into a lidded rubbish bin, then wash hands thoroughly.
